An Ordinance to amend the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trading Hours (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962*.²

Goods other than exempt goods, &c.

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of sub-section (3) and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty—

(a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or

(b) for a third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”; and

- (b) by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of sub-section (4) and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty—

(a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or

(b) for a third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”.

Goods sold at auction

4. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of sub-section (1) and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty—

(a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or

(b) for a third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”.

Delivery of goods at shop

5. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of the section and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty—

(a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or

(b) for a third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”.

Advertisements

6. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of the section and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty—

(a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or

(b) for third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”.

Shopkeepers and managers of shops

7. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “not exceeding \$200” and substituting “not exceeding—

- (a) for a first or second offence—\$2,000; or
- (b) for third or subsequent offence—\$5,000.”.
