REGULATION UNDER THE LEASES ORDINANCE 1918-1919.

I GEORGE FOSTER PEARCE, the Minister of State for Home and Territories, pursuant to the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of the Leases Ordinance 1918-1919, hereby make the following new Regulation, to come into operation forthwith.
