THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT. REGULATIONS UNDER THE PARKS AND GARDENS ORDINANCE 1918.

PARKS AND GARDENS REGULATIONS.

Short Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parks and Gardens Regulations.

Prohibition of Smoking.

2. No person shall smoke any tobacco pipe, cigarette, or cigar, or any material whatsoever in the area known as the Stromlo Plantation, declared under the Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1918 to be a Park. Penalty: Ten pounds.
