## THE FEDERAL CAPITAL COMMISSION.

### REGULATIONS UNDER THE DAIRIES SUPERVISION ORDINANCE 1925.

PURSUANT to the powers conferred upon it by the *Dairies Supervision Ordinance* 1925, the Federal Capital Commission hereby makes the following Regulations to come into operation forthwith.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dairies Supervision Regulations 1926. Short title and citation.
  2. Any person desiring to be registered as a dairyman or milk vendor shall make application in writing to the Commission for registration in accordance with Form A of the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of application for registration.
  3. All dairy premises, factories and milk stores, and all cattle, appliances and utensils therein used for the production or distribution of milk or cream or the manufacture of butter or cheese may be inspected by an officer of the Commission at any reasonable time or times. Inspection of premises, cattle, &c.
  4. Any registered dairyman or milk vendor who ceases to carry on the business of a dairyman or milk vendor shall, within seven days after ceasing to carry on such business, give notice thereof in writing to the Commission. Notification of cessation of business.

### Penalties.

5. Upon the occurrence of any disease in any milking cow in the possession or custody of a dairyman or milk vendor, the dairyman or milk vendor shall forthwith give notice thereof in writing to the Commission.

6. Any person guilty of an offence against or a contravention of these Regulations shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £50.
