

Regulations under the Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1930.

I FRANK ANSTEY, Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1930*, hereby make the following Regulations to come into operation forthwith.

MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS.

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners Registration Regulations.

Executive Officer.

2. The Chairman shall be the Executive Officer of the Board.

Meetings of the Board.

3.—(1.) Meetings of the Board shall be held at such times as the Chairman determines.

(2.) At all meetings, voting shall be by show of hands unless a ballot is called for by any member present.

(3.) No resolution passed, or any act, matter or thing done or authorized to be done, by or at any meeting, shall be rescinded, amended, cancelled or revoked at any subsequent meeting unless notice of the proposed rescission, amendment, cancellation or revocation has been given in the notice convening the meeting.

(4.) Notice of any motion or resolution intended to be proposed at any meeting shall be given to the Chairman in writing at least seven clear days prior to the meeting, and such notice when so delivered shall be embodied in the business paper and sent to members.

(5.) Upon the signing of the Minutes of any meeting by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman at a subsequent meeting, those Minutes shall be binding and conclusive for all purposes.

Particulars in Register.

4. The particulars to be entered into the Register of Medical Practitioners with respect to the registration of any person shall be as follows:—

Number;
Date of Registration;
Name of Practitioner;
Professional Address;
Qualifications.

5. The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration of a person as a medical practitioner shall be £1 1s. Fee for certificate of registration.

6. A Certificate of Registration in the following form, signed by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman, shall be issued to every medical practitioner registered by the Board:— Certificate of Registration.
