Regulations under the Dentists Registration Ordinance 1931.

DENTAL REGULATIONS.

Short title.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations.
- 2. The Chairman shall be the Executive Officer of the Board.

Executive Officer. Meetings of the Board.

- 3.—(1.) Meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and places as the Chairman determines.
 - (2.) At all meetings, voting shall be by show of hands unless a ballot

is called for by any member present.

- (3.) No resolution passed, or any act, matter or thing done or authorized to be done, by or at any meeting, shall be rescinded, amended, cancelled or revoked at any subsequent meeting unless notice of the proposed rescission, amendment, cancellation or revocation has been given in the notice convening the meeting.
- (4.) Notice of any motion or resolution intended to be proposed at any meeting shall be given to the Chairman in writing at least seven clear days prior to the meeting, and such notice when so delivered shall be embodied in the business paper and sent to members.
 (5.) Upon the signing of the Minutes of any meeting by the Chair-
- (5.) Upon the signing of the Minutes of any meeting by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman at a subsequent meeting, those Minutes shall be binding and conclusive for all purposes.

Fee for certificate of registration.

5. The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration of a person as a dentist shall be £1 1s.

Certificate of registration.

6. A Certificate of Registration in accordance with the following form, signed by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman, shall be issued to every dentist registered by the Board:—
