THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Public Baths Ordinance.

I. ARTHUR BLAKELEY, Minister of State for Home Affairs, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Baths Ordinance* 1931, hereby make the following regulations to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.

Regulation ten of the Public Baths Regulations is amended by omitting the proviso to sub-regulation (1) thereto and inserting the following sub-regulations:---

"(1) (a) The holder of a season ticket and any or all of the two adults and the children under fifteen years with respect to whom a family ticket is issued shall be entitled on presenting the ticket at the public baths for which the ticket is issued to admission thereto at all hours during which such baths are open for admission to the public during the season for which the ticket is issued.

(1) (b) For the purposes of this Regulation a season shall be deemed to be the period commencing on the first day of November in any year or such carlier date as the Minister shall determine and ending on the thirty-first day of March in the following year or such subsequent day as the Minister shall determine."
