

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Meat Ordinance 1931.

I, CHARLES WILLIAM OLANAN MARR, Minister of State for Health, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Home Affairs, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*, and the *Meat Ordinance 1931*, hereby make the following Regulation to come into operation forthwith.

MEAT REGULATIONS.

The Meat Regulations 1931 are amended by inserting at the end of regulation 5 the following paragraph:—

“(7.) The Director-General may, on the application of a holder of a permit to slaughter, transfer the permit to any other person named in the application.”
