

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Police Ordinance 1927.

I, JOHN GREIG LATHAM, the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Police Ordinance* 1927, hereby make the following Regulation, to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS UNDER THE POLICE
ORDINANCE 1927 MADE ON 10TH MARCH, 1930, AND
PUBLISHED IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA
GAZETTE OF 13TH MARCH, 1930, AS SUBSEQUENTLY
AMENDED.

1. Regulation 6 of the Police Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting the words "and under the age of thirty-five years,"; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—
 - (2.) a person who is over the age of thirty-five years shall not be appointed as a member of the Police Force unless, for the period of five years immediately preceding his appointment, he has been a Peace Officer."
