## AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 10 of the Public Baths Regulations is amended by omitting sub-Regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-Regulation:—

"(1.) The charges for admission to any public baths, and for hire of towels and bathing constumes, shall be in accordance with the following scale:—
