## THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

### Regulations under the Public Baths Ordinance 1931.

I, JOHN ARTHUR PERKINS, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Baths Ordinance* 1931, hereby make the following Regulations to come into operation forthwith.

### AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 10 of the Public Baths Regulations is amended by omitting sub-Regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-Regulation :—

“(1.) The charges for admission to any public baths, and for hire of towels and bathing costumes, shall be in accordance with the following scale :—
