

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulation under the Dentists Registration Ordinances 1931-1932.

I, CHARLES WILLIAM CLANAN MARR, Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Dentists Registration Ordinances 1931-1932*, hereby make the following Regulation to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF THE DENTAL REGULATIONS.

After regulation 6 of the Dental Regulations, the following regulation is added:—

Unprofessional
conduct.

"7. For the purposes of section thirty of the Ordinance, 'unprofessional conduct' on the part of any registered dentist shall, in addition to the matters already prescribed, include—

- (a) the permitting of the use of his name in connexion with the practice of dentistry at any premises at which he does not regularly practice his profession; and
- (b) the use of any title or description which he is not by the Ordinance entitled to use."
