Regulation under the Education Ordinance 1928-1930.

AMENDMENT OF EDUCATION REGULATIONS.

[~] 1. Regulation 24 of the Education Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in lieu thereof :---

24. Bursaries, of such number as is determined by the Minister, may, Limit of Age. subject to these Regulations, be awarded annually by the Board to boys and girls who are not less than 11 years of age and not more than 13 years of age on the first day of January following the examination, and who, in the opinion of the Board, show the greatest merit in the qualifying examination for bursaries.
