

Regulations under the Education Ordinance 1928-1930.

I, THOMAS PATERSON, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1933* and by the *Education Ordinance 1928-1930*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENT OF EDUCATION REGULATIONS.

Definitions.

1. Regulation 3 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "Attendance Officer" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

"'Attendance Inspector' means the Attendance Inspector appointed by the Minister in pursuance of these Regulations;".

2. The Education Regulations are amended by inserting in Part II. thereof the following regulations:—

Appointment of
Attendance
Inspector.

"3A. The Minister may appoint a person to be the Attendance Inspector.

Institution of
prosecutions.

"3B. A prosecution under the Ordinance may be instituted by, or in the name of, the Attendance Inspector or such other person as the Minister authorizes in writing."

Returns under
sections 9 (1) (c)
and 23 of
Ordinance.

3.—(1.) Regulation 7 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulations (2.) and (3.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-regulations:—

"(2.) Returns in accordance with Forms 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall be forwarded to the Attendance Inspector, Department of the Interior, Canberra, and returns in accordance with Forms 3, 6, 7, 8 and 9 shall be forwarded to the Director of Education.

"(3.) The Director of Education or the Attendance Inspector (as the case may be) may require teachers or proprietors of certified schools to furnish such further returns as he thinks fit with respect to the returns required in pursuance of this regulation to be forwarded to him."

4. Regulation 11 of the Education Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

"11. An application under section 15 of the Ordinance for the registration of a school shall be forwarded to the Director of Education with a request that a report be submitted for the consideration of the Minister."
