

### Regulations under the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936.

I, THOMAS PATERSON, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Baths Ordinance* 1931-1936, hereby make the following Regulations.

1. Regulation 10 of the Public Baths Regulations is amended—
- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the symbols and figures appearing in the column "Use of Locker" and inserting in their stead the following:—

- (b) by inserting in sub-regulation (4.) after the word "towel" (second occurring) the words "or locker";
- (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the words "any earlier day" and inserting in their stead the words "any day prior to that day"; and
- (d) by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the words "any subsequent day" and inserting in their stead the words "any day prior to or subsequent to that day".
