AMENDMENT OF THE CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL BY-LAWS.

Part X of the Canberra Community Hospital By-laws is amended—

(a) by omitting from the provisions headed "*G.—Out-patients Charges*" the words and figures—

(b) by inserting after the provisions headed "*G.—Out-patients Charges*", the following provisions:—
