for registration. | 1. After regulation 4 of the Nursing Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—
“4A. An application for registration shall be made in accordance with Form A of the Schedule to these Regulations.”. |

fee. | 2. Regulation 23 of the Nursing Regulations is amended by omitting the word “Government” and inserting in its stead the word “Community”. |
| Schedule. | 3. The Schedule to the Nursing Regulations is amended by omitting from Forms A and B the letters “F.C.T.” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the letters “A.C.T.”. |
