Regulations 1943. No. 3.

Regulations under the Education Ordinance 1937-1942.*

I, JOSEPH SILVER COLLINGS, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Education Ordinance 1937-1942*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE EDUCATION REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 4 of the Education Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of "public school" the following definition:—

"'qualifying examination' means the qualifying examination for candidates for bursaries conducted by the Department of Education of the State of New South Wales;"

2. Regulation 18 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1.) all the words from and including the words "a quota" to the end of that paragraph and inserting in their stead the words "the amount specified in the undermentioned cases, respectively, where the dependants of the parents or guardian are—

For the purposes of this paragraph, the word 'dependant' includes any relative of a parent or the guardian ordinarily residing with, and wholly maintained by, him or her, as the case may be, but does not include any child or relative earning fifteen shillings or more, per week, or any invalid in respect of whom any deduction has been made from the income in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph."

3. Regulation 27 of the Education Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) all the words from and including the words “a quota” to the end of the sub-regulation and inserting in their stead the words “the amount specified in the undermentioned cases, respectively, where the dependants of the parents or guardian are—

For the purposes of this sub-regulation, the word ‘dependant’ includes any relative of a parent or the guardian ordinarily residing with, and wholly maintained by him or her, as the case may be, but does not include any child or relative earning fifteen shillings or more, per week, or any invalid in respect of whom any deduction has been made from the income in accordance with the provisions of this sub-regulation.”; and

- (b) by inserting after sub-regulation (1.) the following sub-regulations:—

“(1A.) A bursary shall not be granted to any child unless an undertaking, in writing, is given to the Minister by a parent or the guardian that the child shall be kept at school until the completion of the course for which the child is enrolled.

“(1B.) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, the Minister may—

- (a) determine, as he deems fit, by notice in the *Gazette*, by what amount, if any, the maximum amount prescribed by sub-regulation (1.) of this regulation shall be increased where the number of dependants exceeds ten; and
- (b) authorize, where special circumstances appear to him to justify it, the continuation of any bursary where the income of the parents or guardian of the holder exceeds the appropriate amount prescribed or as determined under this sub-regulation.”.

Limit of age.

4. Regulation 30 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting the words “the date fixed for the qualifying examination for bursaries” and inserting in their stead the words “the first day of January following the date fixed for holding the qualifying examination”.

5. Regulation 45 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

Power of
Minister to
remit fees.

“(b) either wholly or in part, remit the payment of any such fee or refund the amount of any fee paid; and”.

6. The First Schedule to the Education Regulations is amended—

First Schedule.

(a) by omitting from Form 13 the words “following the Examination” and inserting in their stead the words “following the date fixed for holding the qualifying examination”;

(b) by inserting in that Form, after the words “This application”, the words “, accompanied by a Statutory Declaration made by the applicant in accordance with Form 14,”; and

(c) by omitting from that Form the words “Bursary and High School examination” and inserting in their stead the words “qualifying examination”.
