Regulations 1944. No. 1.*

Regulations under the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1943.

I, JOSEPH SILVER COLLINGS, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1943*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENT OF THE LIQUOR REGULATIONS.

After regulation 2 of the Liquor Regulations the following regulations and Schedule are added:—

“3.—(1.) The returns to be made by a licensee under section 36 of the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1943* shall be in accordance with Form A in the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of return of liquor purchased.

“ (2.) Where the return relates—

(a) to an application for renewal of a licence—the return shall be in respect of the period of twelve months ending on the thirty-first day of October in the year in which the return is made and shall be furnished to the Registrar not later than the twenty-first day of November in that year; and

(b) to an application for a transfer of a licence—the return shall be in respect of the period commencing on the first day of November next preceding the date of the application and ending on that date and shall be furnished to the Registrar not later than seven days after that date.

“4. The returns to be made by suppliers of liquor under section 37 of the *Liquor Ordinance 1929-1943* shall be in accordance with Form B in the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of return by suppliers of liquor.

STATUTORY DECLARATION.
