Regulations 1945. No. 1.*

Regulation under the Meat Ordinance 1931-1940.

I, JAMES MACKINTOSH FRASER, the Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Meat Ordinance 1931-1940*, hereby make the following Regulation.

AMENDMENT OF THE MEAT REGULATIONS.

Regulation 19 of the Meat Regulations is amended—

Branding.

(a) by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

“(1.) When a Meat Inspector passes meat as fit for human consumption, the Meat Inspector or a person authorized by him in that behalf, shall brand the meat with the prescribed brand, and in the manner prescribed.”; and

(b) by inserting in sub-regulation (4.), after the word “Inspector”, the words “or a person authorized by a Meat Inspector in that behalf”.
