Regulations 1946. No. 6.*

Regulation under the Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1938.

I HERBERT VICTOR JOHNSON, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1938*, hereby make the following Regulation.

AMENDMENT OF THE APPRENTICESHIP REGULATIONS.

Regulation 10 of the Apprenticeship Regulations is amended—

(a) by inserting, after the words “annual leave,” the words “sick leave,”; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—

“(2.) The terms and conditions of employment specified in any current indenture of apprenticeship shall be deemed to be varied from time to time to such extent as is necessary to give effect to the provisions of the last preceding sub-regulation.”.
