AMENDMENT OF THE APPRENTICESHIP REGULATIONS.

Regulation 10 of the Apprenticeship Regulations is amended—

"sick leave,"; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:--"(2.) The terms and conditions of employment specified in any current indenture of apprenticeship shall be deemed to be varied from time to time to such extent as is necessary to give effect to the provisions of the last preceding sub-regulation.".
