Regulations under the Education Ordinance 1937-1947.*

HERBERT VICTOR JOHNSON, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Education Ordinance 1937-1947, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE EDUCATION REGULATIONS.

1.—(1.) Regulation 43A of the Education Regulations is amended by Nursery omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (3.) the words "One hundred and twenty pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "One hundred and sixty pounds".

Scholarships.

- (2.) Regulation 43A of the Education Regulations as amended by the last preceding sub-regulation shall apply, in respect of the year One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and subsequent years, to all Nursery Kindergarten Teacher Scholarships, whether awarded before or after the commencement of this regulation.
 - 2. The Third Schedule to the Education Regulations is amended— Third Schedule.

- (a) by omitting from the form of bond contained therein the words "One hundred and twenty pounds (£120)" (twice occurring); and
- (b) by omitting from that form the words "Two hundred and eighty pounds (£280)".
