Regulations 1951. No. 4.

Regulations under the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1950.*

I, HUBERT LAWRENCE ANTHONY, Minister of State acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1950*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE HOSPITAL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 2 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "the Roll" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

"'the roll' means the roll of electors for the Territory kept in pursuance of the Australian Capital Territory Electoral Regulations."

Definitions.

2. Regulation 5 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Advisory Council Election Regulations" and inserting in their stead the words "Australian Capital Territory Electoral Regulations".

Distinguishing mark to be placed on roll.

3. Regulation 12 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (2.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

"(a) the polling places shall be the polling places appointed within or for the Territory by the Chief Electoral Officer in pursuance of regulation 41 of the Australian Capital Territory Electoral Regulations;"

Action where number of candidates is greater than number required to be elected.

4. Regulation 16 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is amended—

(a) by omitting the proviso thereto; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulations:—

"(2.) Notwithstanding the provisions of the last preceding sub-regulation, a person—

(a) who is resident in the Territory accepted by the Commonwealth in pursuance of the *Jervis Bay Territory Acceptance Act 1915*; and

Application of provisions of Advisory Council Election Regulations generally.

(b) whose name on the roll is marked in accordance with regulation 5 of these Regulations, shall not be entitled to vote at an election.

“(3.) Nothing in this regulation shall be construed as applying the provisions of paragraph (c) of section 73 of the Commonwealth Electoral Act, of paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (3.) of regulation 4 of the Advisory Council Election Regulations or of sub-regulation (3.) of regulation 29 of those Regulations to the nomination of candidates for election under these Regulations.”.
