AMENDMENT OF THE CANBERRA AND JERVIS BAY ELECTRIC SUPPLY REGULATIONS.

Regulation 12 of the Canberra and Jervis Bay Electric Supply Accounts. Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "Ten shillings for reconnexion" and inserting in their stead the words "One pound for discontinuance and reconnexion"; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—
 "(4.) When an officer attends for the purpose of disconnecting the supply and the amount of the account, together with an attendance fee of Ten shillings, is paid to the officer, the supply shall not be discontinued.".
