Regulations under the Police Ordinance 1927-1954.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE POLICE REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 3 of the Police Regulations is repealed.

Repeal of regulation 3.

2. Regulation 4 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Responsibilities the words "Chief Officer" and inserting in their stead the word of Commissioner. "Commissioner".

- 3. Regulation 10 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Police to obey from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Chief Officer" and inserting in commands of their stead the word "Commissioner".
- 4. Regulation 11 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Offences from sub-regulations (2.) and (3.) the words "Chief Officer (wherever punishable by Commissioner. occurring) and inserting in their stead the word "Commissioner".
- 5. Regulation 13 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Travelling from sub-regulation (1.) the words "Chief Officer" and inserting in allowances. their stead the word "Commissioner".
- 6. Regulation 15 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Recreation the words "Chief Officer" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their leave. stead the word "Commissioner".
- 7. Regulation 15AA of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Deductions from from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Chief Officer" and inserting in recreation leave their stead the word "Commissioner".

8. Regulation 15A of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Sick leave for from sub-regulations (1.) and (4.) the words "Chief Officer" (wherever injury sustained or illness occurring) and inserting in their stead the word "Commissioner".

9. Regulation 16 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting sick leave. from sub-regulations (1.) and (2.) the words "Chief Officer" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the word "Commissioner".
