Regulations 1955. No. 4.

Regulations under the Cemeteries Ordinance 1933-1942.*

I WILFRED SELWYN KENT HUGHES, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933-1942*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 6 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

Fees and charges.

“(1.) A fee or charge prescribed in the Third Schedule in respect of a service or other matter specified in that Schedule shall be payable in respect of that service or matter.”

2. Regulation 17 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words “, on payment of the prescribed fee”.

Inspection of register.

3. Regulation 26 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended—

Design and construction of monuments.

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words “, or place any inscription thereon,”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words “, or the placing of any inscription thereon”.

4. Regulation 28 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“28. A person shall not, without the consent of the Trustees—

(a) plant a tree or shrub in the Cemetery;

(b) cover a grave in the Cemetery with tiles, cement, chips or any other covering;

(c) place a vessel or container on a grave in the Cemetery; or

(d) place an inscription on a monument, tablet, gravestone, vault, kerbing, railing or other structure in the Cemetery.”

Planting of trees, covering of graves, &c.
