Regulation under the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1955*.*

AMENDMENT OF THE HOSPITAL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 14 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“14. The ballot-papers to be used for the purposes of an election shall be in accordance with Forms 8 and 9 in the Schedule to the Advisory Council Election Regulations, except that the words ‘Advisory Council’ (wherever occurring) shall be omitted from each of those forms and the words ‘Hospital Board’ inserted in their stead.” Forms of ballot-papers.
