AMENDMENT OF THE HOSPITAL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS.[†]

Regulation 14 of the Hospital Board Election Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:----

"14. The ballot-papers to be used for the purposes of an election shall Forms of be in accordance with Forms 8 and 9 in the Schedule to the Advisory ballot-papers. Council Election Regulations, except that the words 'Advisory Council' (wherever occurring) shall be omitted from each of those forms and the words 'Hospital Board' inserted in their stead.".
