AMENDMENTS OF THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS **REGULATIONS.**†

- 1. Regulation 5 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is Definitions. amended by omitting the definition of "maximum allowable working pressure" and inserting in its stead the following definition:-
 - "'maximum allowable working pressure', in relation to a boiler or pressure vessel, means the maximum allowable working pressure specified in the certificate of inspection for the time being in force in relation to the boiler or pressure vessel;".
- 2. Regulation 22 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is Boilers and amended by omitting sub-regulation (2.).

- 3. Regulation 24 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is Certificate of amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) and inserting inspection. n its stead the following paragraph:—
 - "(a) issue to the operator a certificate of inspection; and".
- 4. Regulation 39 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is Issue of boiler amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance attendant's certificate." with Form 2 in the First Schedule to these Regulations".
- 5. The First Schedule to the Boiler and Pressure Vessels Regulations First Schedule. is repealed.
