## Regulations 1959. No. 20.

### Regulations under the *Plant Diseases Ordinance* 1934–1959.\*

**I** GORDON FREETH, the Minister of State for the Interior hereby make the following Regulations under the *Plant Diseases Ordinance* 1934–1959.

### AMENDMENTS OF THE PLANT DISEASES REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 33 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words “in Form D in the Fourth Schedule” and inserting in their stead the words “in writing”. Neglected trees.

2. Regulation 34 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words “in Form D in the Fourth Schedule” and inserting in their stead the words “given under the last preceding regulation”. Owner liable for cost of destruction of neglected trees.

3. The Fourth Schedule to the Plant Diseases Regulations is repealed. Fourth Schedule.
