## AMENDMENTS OF THE PLANT DISEASES REGULATIONS.<sup>†</sup>

1. Regulation 33 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by  $_{Neglected}$  omitting the words "in Form D in the Fourth Schedule" and inserting trees. in their stead the words "in writing".

2. Regulation 34 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by owner liable omitting the words "in Form D in the Fourth Schedule" and inserting in destruction their stead the words "given under the last preceding regulation".

3. The Fourth Schedule to the Plant Diseases Regulations is repealed. Fourth
