## AMENDMENTS OF THE POLICE REGULATIONS.<sup>†</sup>

1. Regulation 2 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Definitions. sub-regulation (2.).

2. Regulation 11A of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Offences from sub-regulation (4.) the words "a person who has the qualifications minister. of a Stipendiary or Police Magistrate of the Commonwealth or a State or of" and inserting in their stead the words "a Magistrate or".
