### PUBLIC HEALTH (PROHIBITED DRUGS) REGULATIONS.\*

REGULATIONS 1962. No. 9.†

---

Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations is <sup>Prohibited</sup> amended—<sub>drugs.</sub>

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the word “and”; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following word and paragraph:—
  - “; and (c) the drug  $\alpha$ -phthalimidoglutarimide (thalidomide) and a preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing the drug  $\alpha$ -phthalimidoglutarimide (thalidomide) are prohibited drugs.”.
