REGULATIONS 1962. No. 9.†

Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations is Prohibited drugs. amended----

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the word "and"; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following word and paragraph:----
 - "; and (c) the drug α -phthalimidoglutarimide (thalidomide) and a preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing the drug a-phthalimidoglutarimide (thalidomide) are prohibited drugs.".
