## POLICE REGULATIONS\*

## REGULATIONS 1964, No. 4†

After Regulation 11A of the Police Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

Payment of  
salary and  
allowances  
during  
suspension.

“11B. Where a member of the Police Force is suspended under regulation 11 of these Regulations, he shall be paid salary and allowances during the period of suspension unless the Commissioner directs that he shall not be so paid.”.
