1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations.

Repeal.

2. The Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations (comprising Regulations 1965, No. 1) are repealed.

- 3. For the purposes of the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance Prohibited 1957—
 - (a) the drugs specified in the Schedule to these Regulations are prohibited drugs; and
 - (b) a substance containing such a drug is a prohibited drug.
