ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES REGULATIONS*

REGULATIONS 1966, No. 4†

Section 1

Commencement. 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of February, 1966.

The Schedules.

2. The Schedules to the Roads and Public Places Regulations are repealed and the following Schedules inserted in their stead:—

Type of surface	Fee	
Concrete pavement	\$30.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of \$2.00 for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
Bituminous macadam pavement	\$10.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 32 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
Bituminous surfaced pavement	\$10.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 18 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
Gravel pavement	\$6.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 12 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
	SECOND SCHEDULE	Regulation 3 (b).
Type of surface	Fcc	
Concrete pavement	\$6.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 32 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
Bituminous macadam pavement	\$4.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 18 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.	
Bituminous surfaced pavement	\$4.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 18 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken whichever is the greater.	
Gravel pavement	\$2.00 or an amount calculated at the rate of 12 cents for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken whichever is the greater.
