Form 6 in the Schedule to the Advisory Council Election Regulations is Form 6. amended by omitting the words "a State, for the Australian Capital Territory or for the Northern Territory of Australia" and inserting in their stead the words "the Australian Capital Territory, for a State or for the Northern Territory or, where the applicant is outside Australia, an Officer of the Naval, Military or Air Forces of the Commonwealth or of some other part of the Queen's dominions, a person employed in the Public Service of the Commonwealth, a Territory of the Commonwealth or a part of the Queen's dominions or a Justice of the Peace for, or a minister of religion or medical practitioner resident in, a Territory of the Commonwealth or a part of the Queen's dominions".

5. Form 15 in the Schedule to the Advisory Council Election Regulations is Form 15. amended by omitting the words "an elector whose name appears on the Roll for a State, for the Australian Capital Territory or for the Northern Territory of Australia " and inserting in their stead the words " a person whose name appears on the Roll of electors for the Australian Capital Territory, for a State or for the Northern Territory, or a person entitled to be enrolled on such a Roll".

6. Form 17 in the Schedule to the Advisory Council Election Regulations is Form 17. amended by omitting the words "an elector whose name appears on the Roll for a State, for the Australian Capital Territory or for the Northern Territory of Australia" and inserting in their stead the words "a person whose name appears on the Roll of electors for the Australian Capital Territory, for a State or for the Northern Territory, or a person entitled to be enrolled on such a Roll".

7. The Advisory Council Election Regulations are further amended as set out Additional in the Schedule to these Regulations.
