AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS†

- 1. Regulation 24 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended— Number of
 - (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "three feet six inches" allotment, and substituting the figure and word "1 metre"; and
 - (b) by omitting from sub-section (4) the words "six inches" and substituting the figures and word "150 millimetres".
- 2. The Third Schedule to the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Third Schedule. amended—
 - (a) by omitting from item 4 the words "five feet" and substituting the figures and word "1.50 metres"; and
 - (b) by omitting from item 5 the words "six feet" and "five feet" and substituting the figures and words "1.80 metres" and "1.50 metres" respectively.
