## Regulation under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1975.\*

Amendment of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations†

After regulation 4 of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations the following regulation is inserted:-

"4A. Food consisting of fish, crustaceans, molluscs, fish products or canned Contamination fish, shall be deemed to be adulterated if it contains more than one-half of a part of mercury calculated as the metal of mercury per million parts of fish, crustaceans or molluscs, as the case may be.".
