Regulation under the Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1976.*

AMENDMENT OF THE GARBAGE REGULATIONS

Regulation 5 of the Garbage Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:-

"5. (1) The occupier of premises shall not leave or deposit garbage upon or Disposal of garbage. about the premises, or permit garbage to be left upon or about the premises, other than in a receptacle or in a container approved by the Minister or by an authorized officer.

- "(2) A person who fails to comply with sub-regulation (1) is guilty of an offence and is punishable—
 - (a) if an occupier of domestic premises, by a fine not less than \$20 and not more than \$50;
 - (b) if an occupier of commercial premises, where the garbage contained putrescible matter directly or indirectly hazardous to human health, by a fine not less than \$200 and not more than \$500; or
 - (c) in any other case, by a fine not less than \$100 and not more than
