AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 16 of the Motor Omnibus Services Regulations is amended— Tickets to be (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (2B) the words ", subject to subregulation (2c),"; and

- (b) by omitting paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (2c) and substituting the following paragraph:---
 - "(c) a ticket for the fare provided for a journey, being a journey referred to in regulation 6AA of the Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations.".

2. Where, pursuant to a demand made under sub-regulation 16(1) of the Transitional. Motor Omnibus Services Regulations, a person produces for inspection the counterfoil of a ticket referred to in sub-section 3 (2) of the Motor Omnibus Services (Amendment) Ordinance 1977, he shall, at the request of the person making the demand, also produce for inspection a student card issued to him under the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955 and, where he fails to do so, that first-mentioned person shall not be deemed, by virtue of sub-regulation 16 (2B) of those Regulations, to have complied with the demand,
