## Regulations 1979 No. 13

---

### Regulations under the *Pounds Ordinance* 1928<sup>1</sup>

I, ROBERT JAMES ELLICOTT, the Minister of State for the Capital Territory, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Pounds Ordinance* 1928.

### AMENDMENTS OF THE POUNDS REGULATIONS<sup>2</sup>

1. Regulation 2 of the Pounds Regulations is repealed. Repeal
  
2. Regulation 3 of the Pounds Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "the City Area". Interpretation
  
3. Regulations 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Pounds Regulations are repealed and the following regulations substituted:
  
- "4. The following sums are prescribed for the purpose of section 10 of the Ordinance: Pound fees
  - (a) For each entry of an impounding—\$0.30;
  - (b) For each entry of release—\$0.15;
  - (c) For each advertisement published under, or for the purposes of, the Ordinance—the cost of publication plus \$0.30;
  - (d) For each notice delivered or posted—\$0.20;
  - (e) For each sale of cattle the property of one person or, if sold in separate lots, for the sale of each lot—\$1.00;
  - (f) For each entry of sale—\$0.20.

Driving Fees      “5. Driving fees are prescribed for the purpose of section 11 of the Ordinance in accordance with the following scale:

Description of cattle	Rate per kilometre or part of a kilometre

Horses, asses, mules, cows—	
For the first animal . . . . .	0.30
For each additional animal the property of the same owner and impounded at the same time . . . . .	0.10
Sheep—	
Where the number of sheep impounded at the same time does not exceed 100	0.90
Where the number of sheep the property of the same owner and impounded at the same time exceeds 100—	
For the first 100 sheep . . . . .	0.90
For each 100 sheep or portion of 100 sheep after the first 100 . . . . .	0.30
Pigs, goats—	
For each animal . . . . .	0.50

Deterrent fees      “6. (1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), deterrent fees are prescribed for the purpose of section 11 of the Ordinance in accordance with the following scale:

Description of Cattle	Deterrent fees
	\$
Horses, asses, mules, cows—	
For the first animal . . . . .	6.00
For each subsequent animal . . . . .	4.00
Sheep—	
For any number of animals not exceeding 20 . . . . .	2.00
For any number of animals exceeding 20 but not exceeding 50 . . . . .	4.00
For any number of animals exceeding 50 but not exceeding 100 . . . . .	8.00
For each hundred animals or part of one hundred after the first hundred . . . . .	4.00
Pigs, goats—	
For the first animal . . . . .	6.00
For each subsequent animal . . . . .	4.00

“(2) Where an animal is impounded and another animal or other animals of the same kind belonging to the same person have been impounded during the preceding 3 months, the deterrent fees prescribed for the purpose of section 11 of the Ordinance are twice the fees that would be payable but for this sub-regulation.

“7. Trespass rates are prescribed for the purpose of section 11 of the Ordinance in accordance with the following scale: Trespass rates

**4. Regulation 8 of the Pounds Regulations is amended—**

- (a) by omitting “Ten cents” and substituting “30 cents”;
- (b) by omitting “Twenty cents” (wherever occurring) and substituting “60 cents”; and
- (c) by omitting “Forty cents” and substituting “\$1.20”.
