Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) (Solicitors' Costs) Regulations² (Amendment)

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) (Solicitors' Costs) Regulations.

Increase in costs—2 November 1987 to 2 February 1988

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (2) all the words after "expiration of" and substituting "2 February 1988".

Increase in costs—from 3 February 1988

3. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (2) all the words after "commenced" and substituting "during the period that commenced on 3 February 1988 and ended at the expiration of the day preceding the date of commencement of regulation 9".

Insertion

4. After regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

Further increase in costs

"9. (1) In these Regulations, a reference to—

- (a) the costs ascertained in accordance with an item in a Schedule; or
- (b) a scale of costs set out in a Schedule;

shall be read as a reference to those costs, or that scale of costs, respectively, increased by 11.56%.

"(2) Subregulation (1) applies only in relation to work or services the performance of which commenced on or after the commencement of this regulation.".
