## **Boxing Control Regulations<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)**

**Subordinate Law No. 32 of 1995<sup>2</sup>**

### **Commencement**

**1. (1)** This regulation commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) Regulation 2 commences, or shall be taken to have commenced, as the case requires, on 19 August 1995.

**Prescribed contests, displays and exhibitions**

2. Regulation 3 of the Boxing Control Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (f) “and”; and
- (b) by inserting after paragraph (g) the following paragraphs:
  - “(h) at the Turner Police and Citizens’ Youth Club, McKay Gardens, Turner on 19 August 1995 promoted by the Canberra Police and Citizens’ Youth Club; and
  - (i) at the Jamison Inn, Bowman Street, Macquarie on 20 August 1995 promoted by Sandra Orr;”.
