12 Prescribed public places—certain skate parks

- (1) For the Act, section 139 (5), definition of *prescribed public place*, paragraph (c), each of the following public places is declared to be a public place to which the Act, section 139 applies:
 - (a) the skate park and a 2m surround in blocks 59 and 61 of section 65 in the Division of Belconnen and with frontage on Emu Bank, Belconnen;
 - (b) the skate park and a 2m surround in block 4 of section 62 in the Division of Greenway in the Tuggeranong Town Park between the Tuggeranong Pool and Recreation Centre (corner of Athllon Drive and Anketell Street) and Lake Tuggeranong;
 - (c) the skate park and a 2m surround in parkland immediately north of the intersection of Mirrabei and Gundaroo Drives in the Division of Gungahlin;
 - (d) the skate park and paved picnic area and a 2m surround in block 3 of section 22 in the Division of Weston and with frontage on the cycle path (block 6 of section 22 in the Division of Weston) beside Dillon Close, Weston.
- (2) Maps indicating the prescribed public places are set out in schedule 2.
