1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Transplantation and Anatomy Regulations 2001*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day they are notified in the Gazette.

3 Other qualifications for certification of brain death—the Act, s 30 (1)

One of the medical practitioners who can certify brain death must be a specialist neurologist or neurosurgeon or have 1 of the following qualifications:

- (a) Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians, Intensive Care (FRACP (Intensive Care));
- (b) Fellow of the Faculty of Intensive Care, Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (FFICANZCA).
