610A Remandees—clothing

- (1) The chief executive may require all remandees at a correctional centre to wear clothing provided by the chief executive if the chief executive believes on reasonable grounds that it is necessary, having regard to 1 or more of the following:
 - (a) the risk of harm to remandees and other people from certain clothing or parts of clothing that may otherwise be worn;
 - (b) the protection of vulnerable remandees;

- (c) the maintenance of security or good order at the correctional centre;
- (d) the safety of visitors and staff at the correctional centre.
- (2) This section is a law to which the Legislation Act, section 88 (Repeal does not end effect of transitional laws etc) applies.
