Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Security Industry Amendment Regulation 2012* (*No 1*).

2 Commencement

(1) Sections 3 and 4 commence on the day after this regulation's notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

(2) The remaining provisions commence immediately after the commencement of the *Security Industry Amendment Act 2011*, part 3.
